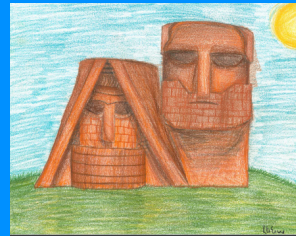


ARS SCHOLARSHIPS

Annually, the ARS awards scholarships to deserving students who are pursuing their higher education (undergraduate and graduate programs).

Conducted biannually, YCP brings together young minds from across the United States for thought-provoking discussions on vital topics.



CAMP HAIASTAN

The ARS EUSA continues to play a vital role in the growth of Camp Haiastan, by generously funding ongoing projects and supporting campers as sponsors.

In 2023, ARS EUSA and its chapters jointly donated \$100,000 to renovate the camp's kitchen.



AID TO ARTSAKH



After the mass exodus, ARS EUSA began an urgent fundraising appeal to provide immediate assistance to families from Artsakh as they began to rebuild their lives in Armenia. Long term programs to further assist these families will be implemented.



EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE

In response to the aftermath of the earthquake in Syria, the ARS EUSA supported the work of the Armenian Relief Cross of Syria who provided vital support such as blankets, meals, medicine, and essential supplies, to community members demonstrating our continuous dedication to their welfare. Likewise, amid challenges in the Armenian community of Lebanon, we have contributed to the Armenian Relief Cross of Lebanon's Hot Meal Program, initiated a library at the United Armenian College, and extended assistance to their devoted educators.

Since 1997, the center serves the residents of Akhourian and neighboring families. Families from Artsakh will also receive free services from the center.
